



Dynazol is a fantastic product for washing off unfixed dye on cotton, wool or silk. When it's used in the dyebath it eliminates spots and streaks. It can be used as a wetting agent to improve evenness or when dissolving your dye to improve solubility. You can also use it to remove sizing from fabric

Hand wash

- * Fill a laundry trough or plastic bucket with hot water.
- * Add 1- 2ml of Dynazol per litre of water.
- * After finishing your dyeing, squeeze out excess dye solution.
- * Submerge dyed fabric and move it around in the bath for 5 to 10 minutes. Rinse well in warm water. This eliminates many rinses.

Washing machine

- * Fill your washing machine with hot water.
- * Once the washing machine is filled, add 30mls of Dynazol.
- * Add your dry cotton fabric and let the machine run for a 10 to 12 minute wash. Let the machine run through the full washing cycle with a warm rinse, then dry.

Dynazol presoak before dyeing

- * Fill a plastic bucket with enough hot water to cover your fabric.
- * Add 1ml per litre of Dynazol.
- * Add your fabric and soak it for 5 minutes. Squeeze out excess water and add it to the dyebath.

Dissolving dye with Dynazol

- * Place required amount of dye in a small beaker
- * Mix with enough Dynazol to form a paste
- * Pour on hot water and stir thoroughly to dissolve the dye
